- B. Challenges for New Year:

- C. As we enter into a new year, how will we answer the Lord's call?

I. GOD'S UPWARD CALL IN CHRIST JESUS.

- A. Faithfulness Answering God's Call.
 - 1. Learn from Abraham to answer no matter how hard it may be.
 - 2. Learn from Jeremiah to answer no matter how alone we may be.
 - 3. Learn from Daniel to answer no matter how threatening it may be.
 - 4. Learn from Esther to answer no matter how impossible it may be.
 - 5. More examples in Hebrews 11.
- B. The Call Given Must Be Answered and Lived.
 - 1. The call is to faithful obedience.
 - 2. God's revelation revealed in Christ, John 1:1-4, 14.
- C. The Upward Call is not a Surprise.
 - 1. Paul used similar language in this section:
 - a. Gaining Christ, 3:8.
 - b. Being found in Him, 3:9.
 - c. Having faith in Him, 3:9.
 - 2. Answering the call was about being in Christ being one with Him.
 - 3. Those of us in Christ must always be about sharing Christ with those who are not.

II. GOD'S UPWARD CALL TRANSFORMS OUR THINKING.

- A. Transformation in the New Testament.
 - 1. Begins from the time of our baptism to our resurrection.

- 2. We are in a constant struggle between flesh and spirit, Rom. 8:5-8.
- 3. We are being and we have been transformed by the blood of Christ.
- 4. Being transformed means we are new creations in Christ, 2 Cor. 5:17.
 - a. We should think differently.
 - b. We should have a transformed perspective.
 - c. Proclamation of identity, Phil. 3:3.
 - d. Declaration of citizenship, 3:20.
- 5. Effective growth involves:
 - a. Spending time in the Scriptures and in prayer.
 - b. Thinking different from the world, Phil. 4:8-9.
 - d. Encouraged to be loyal and true, 3:16.
- 6. Focus in our thinking:
 - a. Evaluate situations in life.
 - b. Better equipped to distinguish from error, godliness from worldliness, Spirit from flesh.
 - c. Viewing the world through Christian "lenses".

III. GOD'S UPWARD CALL MOTIVATES US TO PRESS ON.

- A. The Christian Life is Dynamic.
 - 1. Words "ahead," "goal," "prize," and "upward".
 - 2. Many have weakened in their faith, allowing themselves to become apathetic or stagnate.
 - a. Paul kept on keeping on.
 - 3. We have been called by God Himself.
 - a. The highest calling possible. There is No Greater Calling!
 - b. Leading to our ultimate destination.
- B. The Importance of Effort.
 - 1. Words "gain," "straining," and "press on."
 - 2. Our effort does not take the place of the blood of Christ.
 - 3. But our effort must show our "all-in" response to the salvation received in Christ.
 - 4. Jesus said the same, Luke 9:23.
- C. The Christian Life Has Direction.
 - 1. It is always leading upward.
 - 2. Contrasted with mutilation and confidence in the flesh in Phil. 3:2-3.
 - 3. Contrasted with those who walk as enemies of the cross, Phil. 3:18-19.
 - 4. Our direction is ever moving toward Christ.
 - a. His way of thinking, speaking and acting.
 - b. Living as people already residents of heaven!
